Re: TORONTO TAXICAB VEHICLE REPLACEMENT

Dear xxxxxxxxx xxxxxxxxxxxx,

Records of Municipal Licensing and Standards, Licence and Permit Issuance Office, indicate the vehicle for your Taxicab Owner plate, No.xxxx, is due for replacement by MARCH 31ST 2025.

As per the Interpretation Bulletin updated on August 2024:

- Taxicabs and limousines manufactured in 2013, 2014, 2015 or 2016 and registered as of July 21, 2022 and January 1, 2024 need to be replaced by March 31, 2025. Other 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2016 vehicles are not allowed to be in use.
- Taxicabs and limousines manufactured in 2017 need to be replaced by March 31, 2025.
- Accessible taxicabs manufactured in 2013 and 2014 must be replaced by March 31, 2025.

This means, as the holder of a taxicab owner licence, you can either:

1. Register a replacement vehicle. For requirements please visit our website https://www.toronto.ca/services-payments/permits-licences-bylaws/taxis/taxi-owners/taxicabowner-sale/ OR

2. Bring the plate to our office on a Tuesday or Thursday between 8:30am-4:00pm for safe keeping until a new vehicle is ready to be registered. Please note we are closed between 12:30pm-1:30pm daily.

Failure to complete one of the above may result in a tribunal hearing to determine whether your Toronto Taxicab Owner's Licence should be revoked, suspended, or have conditions placed on it.
